### **Three Years Later**

Our story began in August of 2020, when Will was rushed to the hospital. We learned he was in kidney failure and almost lost him. Will was immediately put on dialysis, and the impact on both him and the family was substantial. The doctor's appointments were never-ending, he was in pain, and was surrounded by others in the same situation where there was a constant fear that he would endure this forever. The surroundings were challenging and it was difficult to remain positive.


On July 1st of 2021, I received the greatest phone call of my life... I WAS THE MATCH to donate a kidney to Will! I cannot fully describe the emotions I experienced hearing from the medical team at Emory Hospital after many months of testing. We asked people to pray for Will, me, our family, and the medical staff. Millions of people worldwide read our post and offered prayers and support.



We want to empower people to go to their doctor if they are feeling ill, understand kidney disease and get tested, support those in need, learn their family history and how to become an organ donor. We know God had a plan, and our mission is now to share our experience and serve others.

In the time since, we have successfully passed the "Giving the Gift of Life Act" in Georgia and

The outpouring of support these past three years is still overwhelming, heartwarming, and simply more than words can describe. Will and I are both doing great!
